



## **City of St. John April 8, 2025 Election Filing Dates**

The 2025 Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, April 8, 2025. The following seats will be open:

Mayor of the City of St. John  
Councilperson - Ward I-(Meghan O'Brien - Incumbent)  
Councilperson - Ward II-(Lee Taylor - Incumbent)

Filing for this election opens at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 8, 2024 and closes at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 22, 2024. Petitions are available at City Hall, located on the first floor of the St. John Municipal Center, 8944 St. Charles Rock Road.

In order to file for office, candidates must:

- ▶ Be a current resident of St. John
- ▶ Have legally resided in St. John for one year or more
- ▶ Be 21 years of age or older
- ▶ Currently be a registered voter in St. John
- ▶ Be current with payment of all City, County, and State taxes

Candidates meeting the above requirements must file a petition (supplied by City Hall) with the City Clerk containing the signatures of ten (10) qualified voters, who shall be designated as their sponsors. (Sponsors for a candidate for Ward Councilman must be residents of the Ward for which the candidate is nominated). No voter shall sign more than (1) petition for the office of Mayor and one (1) petition for the office of Ward Councilman and, if a voter signs more than one (1) that signature shall be void. The signatures shall be executed in indelible ink. Nominees are not allowed to sign their own petition. The filing fee is \$10 and must accompany the petition at the time of filing.
